3. Legal Basis for Processing:

The processing of my personal data is based on:

- Legal obligation (Article 6(1)(c) and Article 9(2)(g) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 – GDPR).
- Regulation (EU) 2021/1060 of the European Parliament and of the Council.
- Regulation (EU) 2021/1057 of the European Parliament and of the Council (establishing the European Social Fund Plus).
- Applicable national, international, and EU law relevant to Beneficiaries in implementing the Project.

4. Method of Data Collection:

Data is obtained directly from the data subjects (participants) or from institutions and entities involved in the Project's implementation, in particular from Beneficiaries and Partners.

5. Access to Personal Data (Recipients):

Access to my personal data is granted to the employees and associates of the Controller. In addition, my personal data may be provided or made available to:

- Other entities to which the Coordinator (FIIW) has assigned specific project-related tasks.
- Bodies of the European Commission.
- Entities authorized under separate legal provisions, including for audits, inspections, and investigations (e.g. OLAF, EPPO, ECA).
- Entities conducting evaluation studies and controls.

6. Data Retention Period:

Personal data will be stored for the period necessary to achieve the purposes specified in point 2, and in any case at least 5 years after project completion, i.e. until 1 September 2033. If audits, reviews, or investigations are ongoing, documentation must be retained until their completion.

7. Rights of Data Subjects:

In accordance with GDPR, I have the following rights:

- The right to access my data and obtain a copy thereof (Article 15 GDPR).
- The right to rectify my data (Article 16 GDPR).
- The right to delete my data (Article 17 GDPR) – subject to the exceptions in Article 17(3) GDPR.
- The right to request restriction of data processing (Article 18 GDPR).
- The right to data portability (Article 20 GDPR) – if processing is based on a contract.
- The right to lodge a complaint with the supervisory authority – the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (Article 77 GDPR).

8. Automated Decision-Making:

Personal data will not be subject to automated decision-making, including profiling.
